- The foundation for grammatical literature of Sanskrit are comprised in the 8 chapters written by Maharshi Panini entitled “Ashtadhyayi”.
- “Ashtadhyayi” is considered to be one of the most scientific & unique works.

MAHESHWAR SUTRA

■ Akshar Samamnaya, Shiva-sutra

■ These are the 14 sutras obtained by the grace of Lord Shiva.

■ Panini got these sutras through Maheshwar when he was doing Tandav Nritya for the sake of “Loka-kalyana”(welfare of the Universe).By hearing the drum beat for 14 times Panini could grasp the sound like these sutras.

■ Maheshwar sutras are like key letters for the Sanskrit Grammer.To make the Pratyahar (abbreviations) in Sanskrit Grammatical Rules

Panini has utilised these Maheshwar sutras .

In Sanskrit Varnamala (Alphabets) 48 letters are there out of which 42 are considered in Maheshwar sutras.
